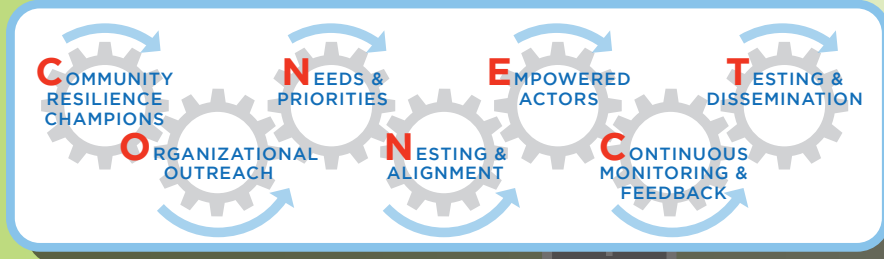
My community is not immune to disasters.
