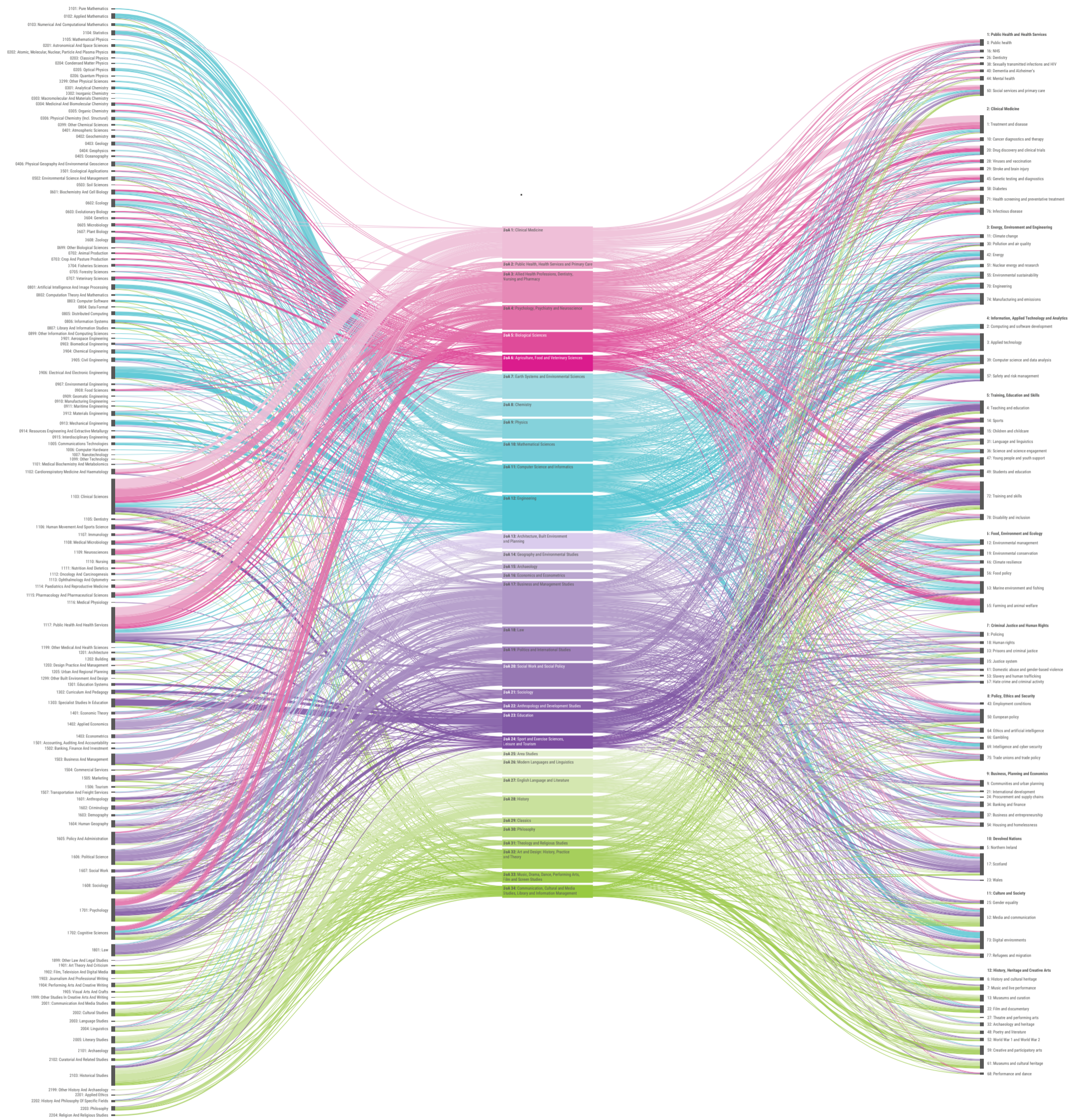


Alluvial diagram illustrating pathways from Scottish university ICSs' underpinning research to resulting impact
