Huma	:	Field for dry rice irrigation or newly cleared land for agriculture

Insus	:	Intensifikasi Khusus/specific intensification
Kabupaten	:	District (or Regency)
Kaki Lima	:	Sidewalk vendors
Karang Taruna	:	Neighbourhood Youth Association
Karawitan	:	Javanese or Sundanese gamelan music and singing accompanied by a gamelan

KCK	:	Kredit Candak Kulak, credit extended to small middlemen

Langgar	:	Islamic prayer house, not used for Friday prayers
LKMD	:	Lembaga Ketahanan Masyarakat Desa, lit. Village Defense Institute, village social activities group
Ojek	:	Motorcycle or bicycle used for public transport
PAM	:	Perusahaan Air Minum, Municipal Water Corporation
PDAM	:	Perusahaan Daerah Air Minum, Municipal Waterworks
Pedati	:	horse-drawn cart
Pencak Silat	:	Form of traditional self-defense/martial arts
Perhimpunan Petani Pemakai Air (P3A):	:	Association of Water Using Farmers
PKK	:	Pendidikan Kesejahteraan Keluarga. Program at the village level to educate womenn on various aspects of family welfare
PML	:	Pemeriksa Sensus Lengkap, Full Census Investigators
Puskesmas	:	Pusat Kesehatan Masyarakat, Community Health Center)
Propinsi	:	Province
PU	:	Pekerjaan Umum, Public Works
Pura	:	Hindu temple
Sawah lebak	:	Rice field in swampy area
Sawah pasang surut	:	Rice field dependent on river water for irrigation, and influenced by the rise and fall of the tides (pasang surut = rise and fall of the tides)
Sawah polder	:	
Sawah tadah Hujan	:	Rice fields dependent on rainwater for irrigation
Surau	:	small Muslim prayer house, not used for Friday prayers
Swadaya	:	Self-supporting
Swakarya	:	Self- developing

Sawsembada	:	Self-supporting, self-sufficient
SPT	:	Satuan Pemukiman Transmigrasi, Unit for Transmigration Settlement
Tambak	:	Fishpond made by damming. Tambak pesisir: coastal pond.
Tanah bengkok/pelungguh:		Rice field given in usufruct to village officials
Tanah kering	:	Dry, unirrigate field
Tanah sawah	:	Wet rice field
Tebat	:	Fish pond created by a dam
Tegal	:	Dry (not irrigated) field near the rice fields but used for vegetables and other secondary crops
UPT	:	Unit Pemukiman Transmigrasi, Transmigration Settlement Unit
Vihara	:	or Wihara, Buddhist temple/monastery/nunnery
Wayang Orang	:	Javanese stage plays with themes from Hindu or Javanese epics
